By Erika Ornstein While the title holds true, there are 55 beautiful patterns, well, not quite, but, close enough. The problem is that for the majority of the images, the resolution is poor. I'll admit I haven't taken the time to color one yet, so, maybe that won't matter much once you are actually engaged in the task of coloring the mandala - but, it was a huge disappointment. I also expected a nice intro of how to use the coloring book like most mandala coloring books have - not that I need it, but, it's always nice to get different points of views on the benefits of coloring mandalas and tips and whatnot. I keep flipping through the book and there are so many mandalas that don't look like they need any color - that they weren't intended to have any and that they are just right in black and white. A lot of them look like Zentangles now that I think about it. And the last third of the coloring book has mandalas in a completely different style, like a optical illusion type

graphic style - definitely not like that intricate beauty on the cover. Oh, and FYI the last page of the book indicated that it was printed on November 3, 2013 (the day after I ordered it) - don't get me wrong, it's nicely bound and professional, and it looks like a regular coloring book, but, it appears to be a self-published one, not that the artist gives themselves any credit. Bottom line - unless I just got a poorly printed copy - the resolution is poor. Many of the images look like Zentangles and don't have much room or need for color.
