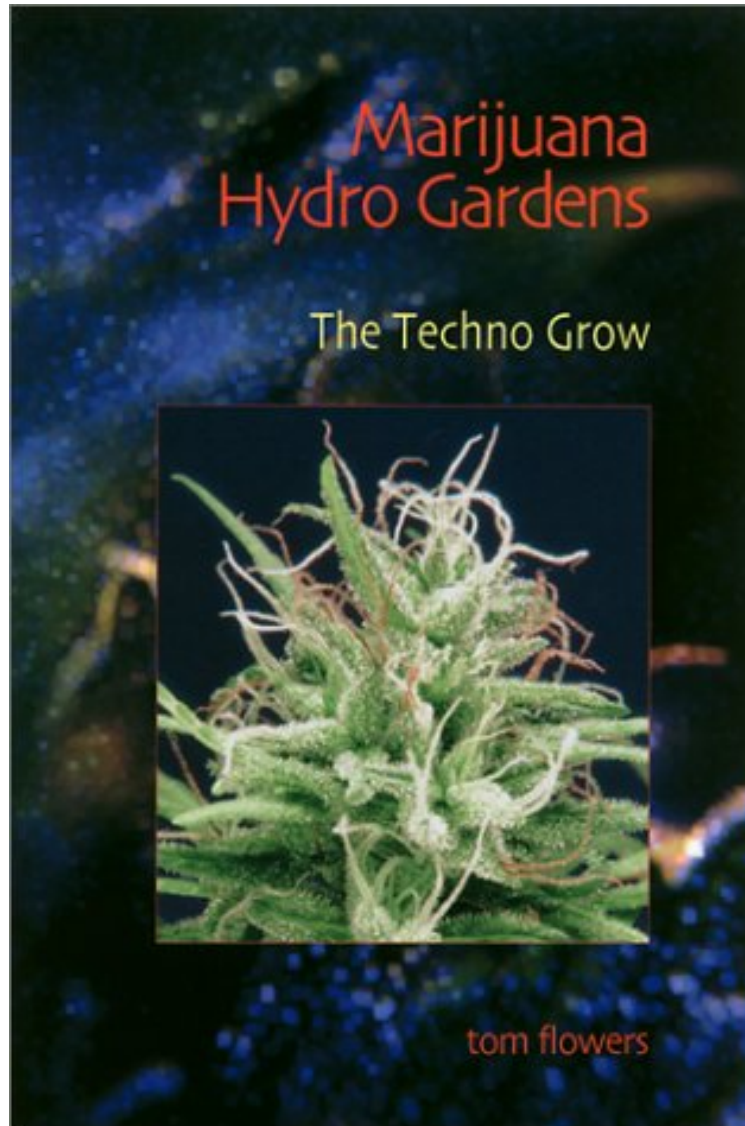

On the other hand, it discusses nutrients, equipment, and Pests very well.
