The instructions were only diagrams so probably not for the first timer with paper models. It only took about 6 hours for me to put together, but I've had some experience with paper models. Good paper to use, very sturdy and looks great at the end. The only tools needed for the construction were a X-Acto blade, ruler and paper glue. The finished product is very detailed and looks great. The clip and pin are removable to add to the realism. Slightly bigger than a real grenade but doesn't take away from the realism either. If you enjoy it as much as I did I would recommend moving to the bigger and more complicated guns made by the same company, just as I am, such as this - Ak47 Paper Gun Model Kit.
