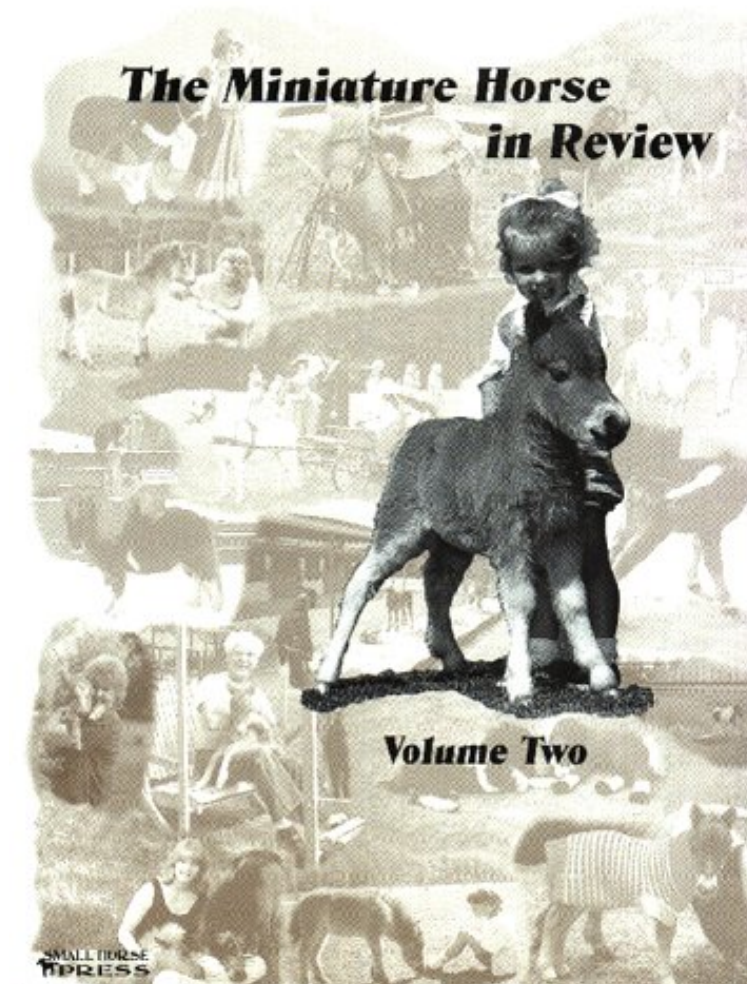

This book also contains essays and content on practical aspects that does not present in many books on horses such as financial and insurance aspects of keeping a miniature horse. This book is designed as a practical management guide for miniature horse keeping rather than providing a plain factual or pictorial aspect on these horses.
