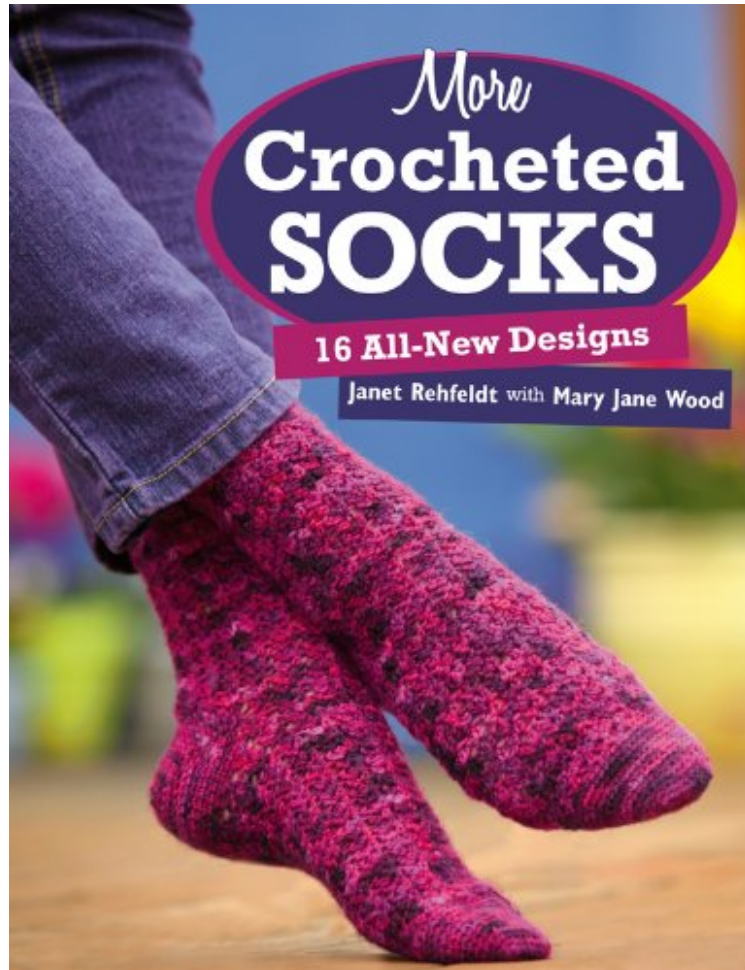

They cover basic socks to fancy lace socks, and socks made with yarn from lace to fingering to DK weight. This is like a survey course in socks crocheting methods, and I think that's what I like the most about it. You are learning a bunch of different methods, so you can tell what your favorite way is to make a sock! This book does more than just teach you individual patterns, but introduces you to methods, which enables you to either design your own sock patterns, or to find the ones you'll enjoy crocheting. 6 of 6 people found the following review helpful. pricey for any beginner.
