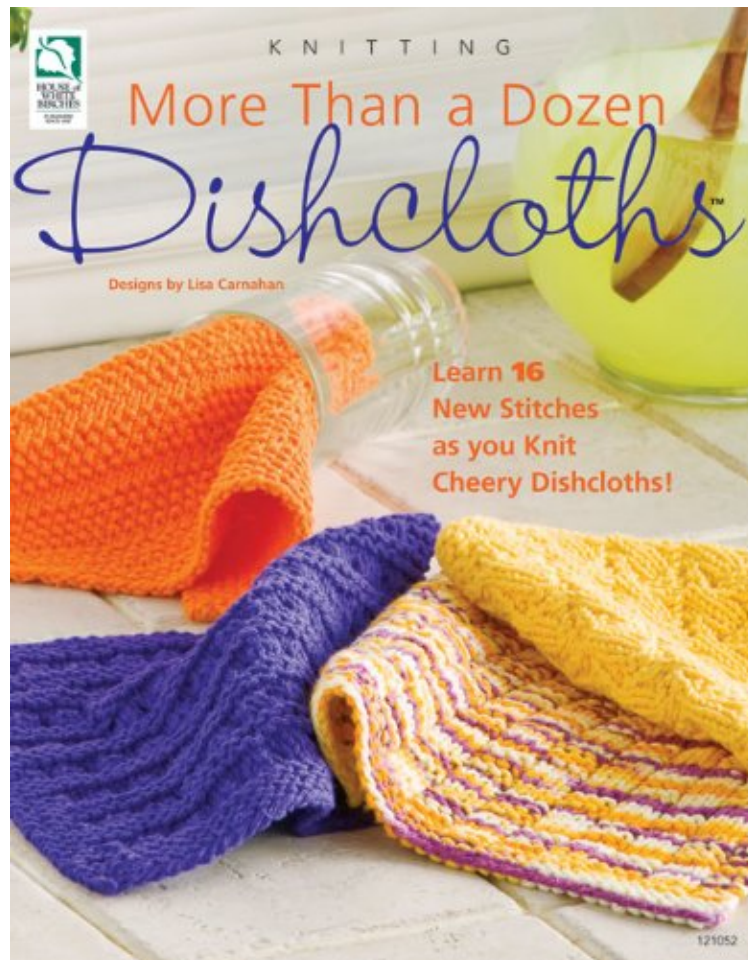

Composed of only knit and purl stitches, the dishcloth patterns detailed in this knitting collection are a great handmade touch for any kitchen. The book includes 16 new pattern stitches and is buttressed by color photographs and tips for better knitting results.
