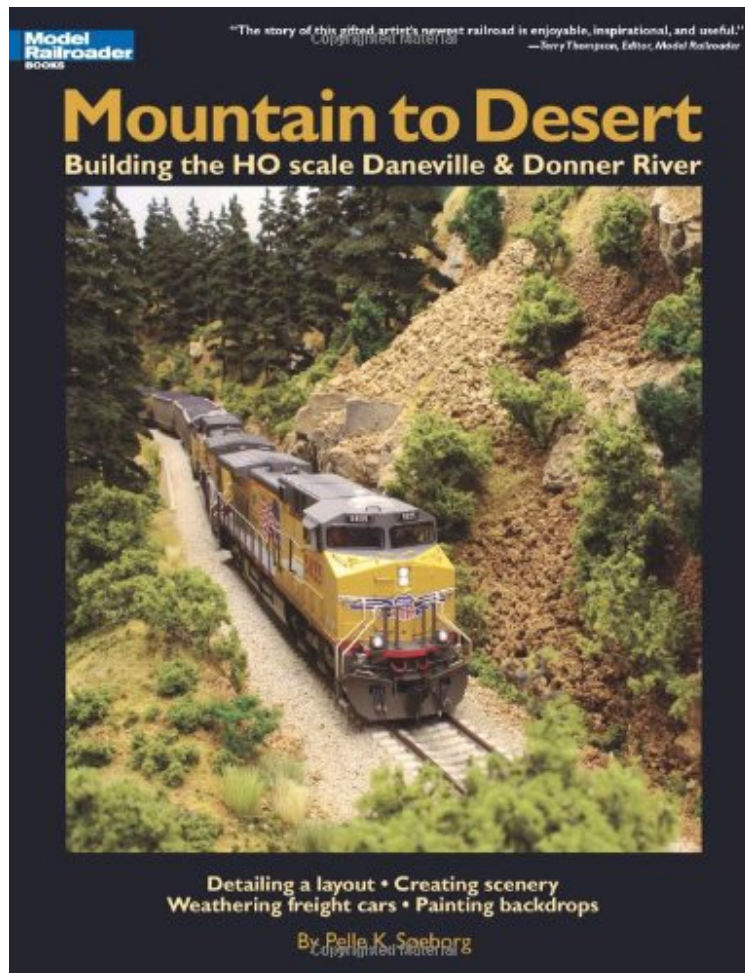

I too am modeling a combination of mountain and desert, and it is very useful to review Pelle's materials list and then flip to the photos to see how he actually did it. The "how-to" sidebars are also instructive.Pelle models the modern era, so he does discuss the challenges of "keeping up." He also has some unique methods: he uses a laser milling machine to create his structures and oil paints for his back drops. But the real value of this book, to me, is that it provides a complete and detailed view of an outstanding model railroad, created by an artist who has visited the areas personally, and then describes how we can accomplish many of the same effects.I highly recommend this book, especially for those of us who model mountains or deserts.
