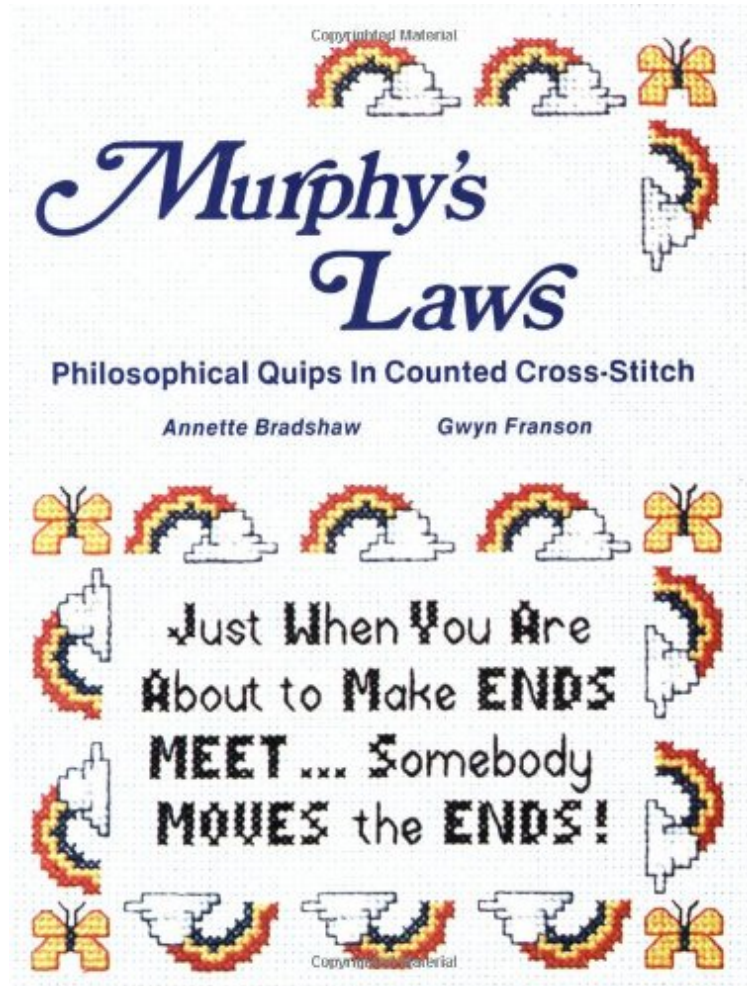

Each saying is a cute quip on the frustrations of life. They are: Just when you are about to make ends meet... somebody moves the ends!; If you can't get your days work

done in 24 hours, work nights; Indecision is the key to flexibility; The light at the end of the tunnel is probably an oncoming locomotive!; If everything seems to be coming your way, you're probably in the wrong lane; If it works, don't fix it!; When you leave the laundromat with an even number of socks, you have someone else's laundry!; Just when you get your head above water, somebody pulls your flippers off!; A pat on the back is only a few centimeters from a kick in the pants; Elephants never forget-but what does an elephant have to remember?; One can't participate in the march of time without getting a few blisters; Obviously William Tell didn't know about Murphy's law.
