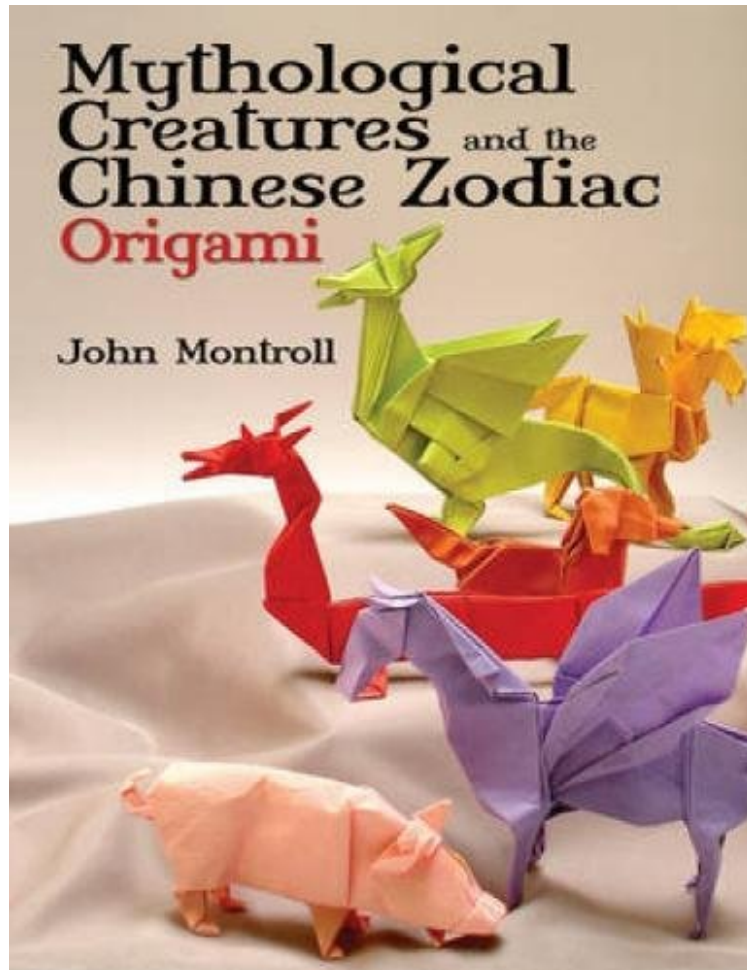

My favorites are the the wyvern, western dragon, sea serpent, griffin and three headed dragon. I particularly appreciate that each of the finished models are like bases in which you can shape the model to your own liking/style. This allows for more artistic choice and playing around. None of these models are complex if you have decent experience with origami. But if you're like me and cultivated your origami skills mostly through YouTube videos, I

recommend gradually working up to the "four star" models as the instructions become less and less. It has easy to follow diagrams AND the designs of the models are surprisingly much more straightforward than I would have thought. If you are an absolute beginner, you may find it pretty difficult to fold a good number of these (Origami, like anything else, takes practice).
