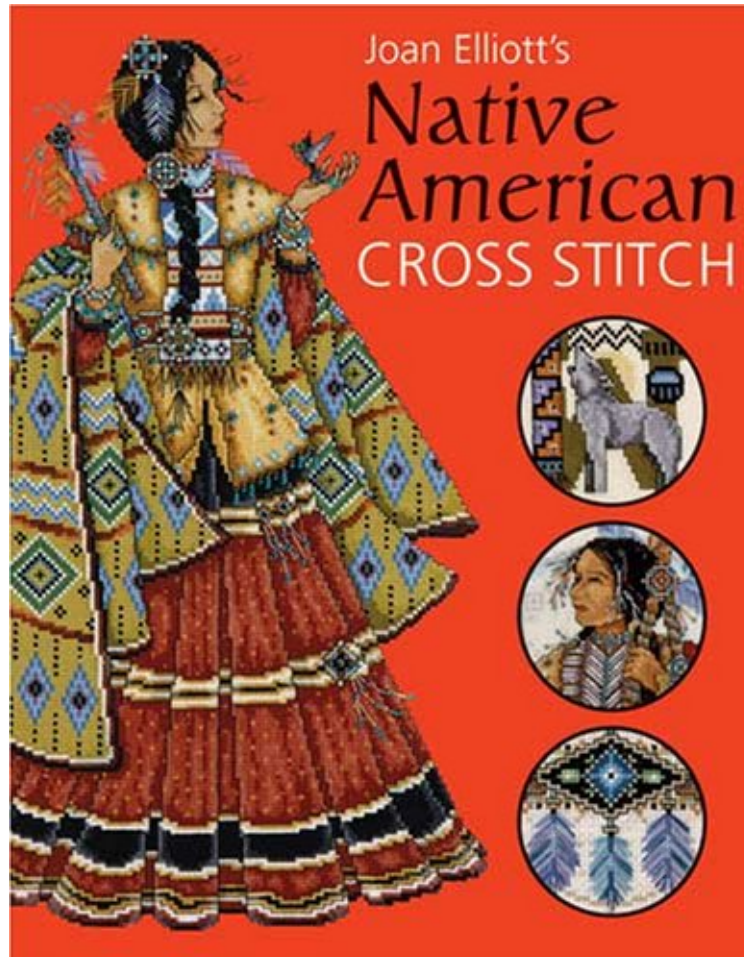

There are very charming (without being overly-cute) designs for a birth sampler, baby blanket, bibs and more.
