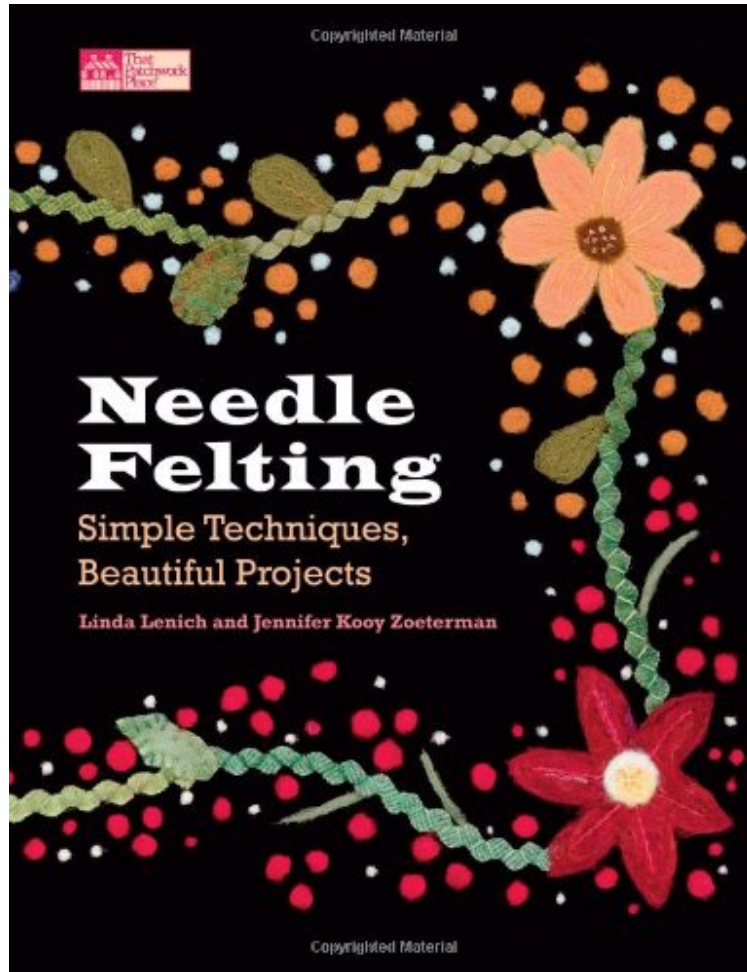

Very simplistic - only covers 2D "imitation embroidery" By Bird That Flew This book is very, very simplistic. It covers two dimensional needle felting only (no sculptural or 3D work). It is also not very clear on materials and references only the authors' (VERY expensive) supply store. This type of needle felting is basically an imitation of embroidery, which in my opinion doesn't warrant an entire book of instructions. There are patterns included and are very similar to the one on the cover - feminine, floral, simplistic, and a little boring. I didn't like this book because it covers only a tiny facet of what

needle felting can be. The book never states that, and if this was your first introduction to this art, then you might not ever know. 0 of 0 people found the following review helpful.
