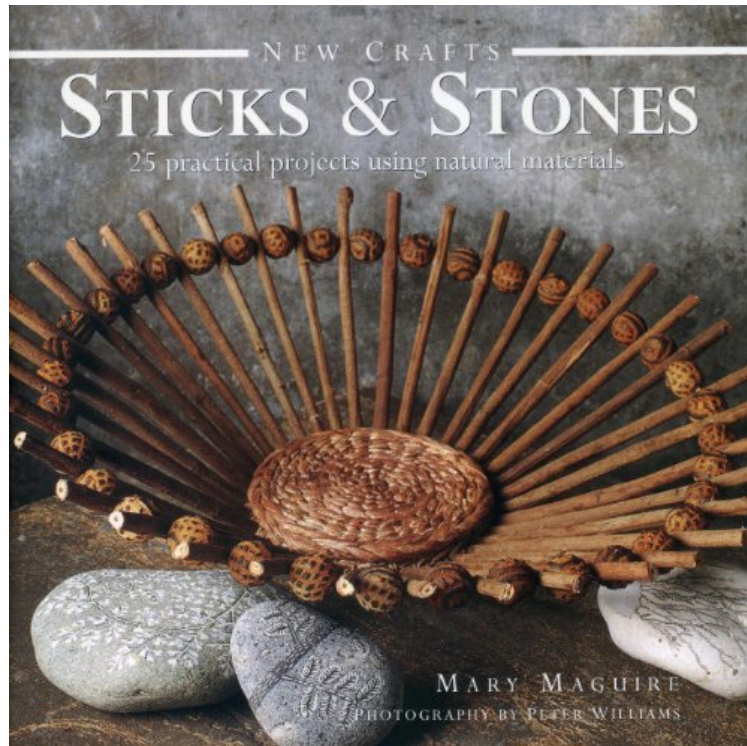

But many are the kind we've seen in other craft books: a journal covered with sticks, a tile made of stones, a table made of sticks.
