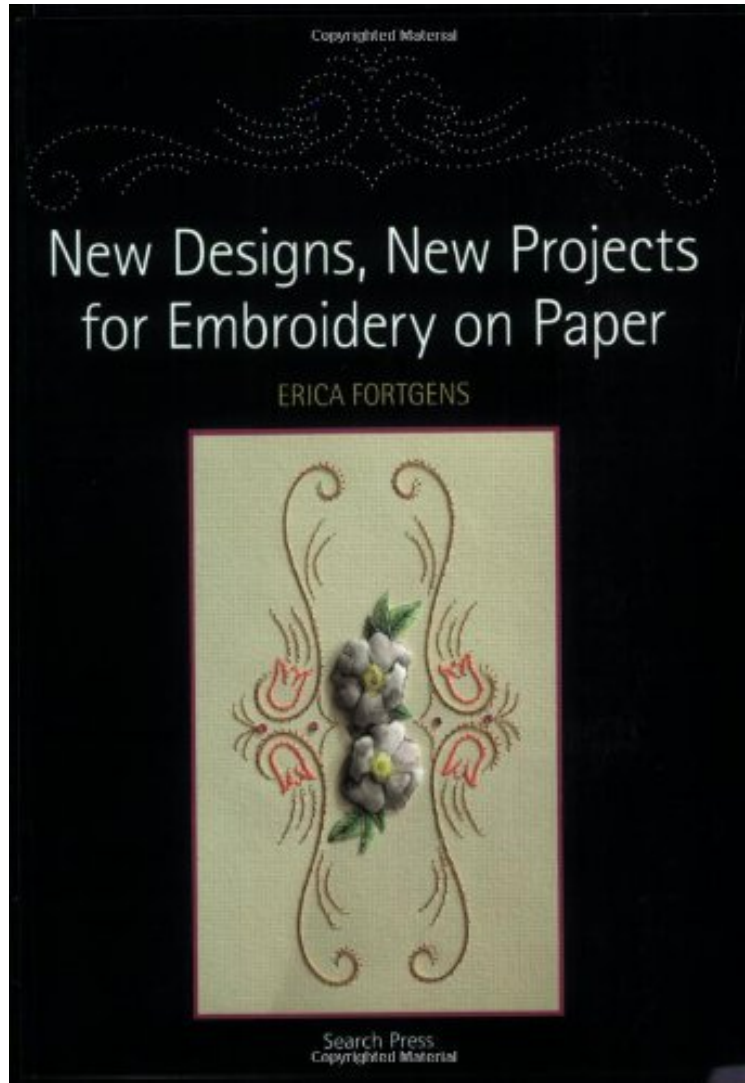

A Bit Small , but UsefulBy shari ulmanThe first item to address is the small size of the book, and you must cut out the pages to effectively enlarge the patterns.The second thing to be aware of is that specific templates are needed to produce some of the samples.I was happy to see that most of the samples had a pattern, and they were easy to follow.Please be aware that making one card may take 4-6 hours of hand work. They are beautiful, unique and very time consuming. Some of the samples used specific 3-D sheets that may not be easily obtained. The book was published in 2009 , and references many items out then, and from European and
