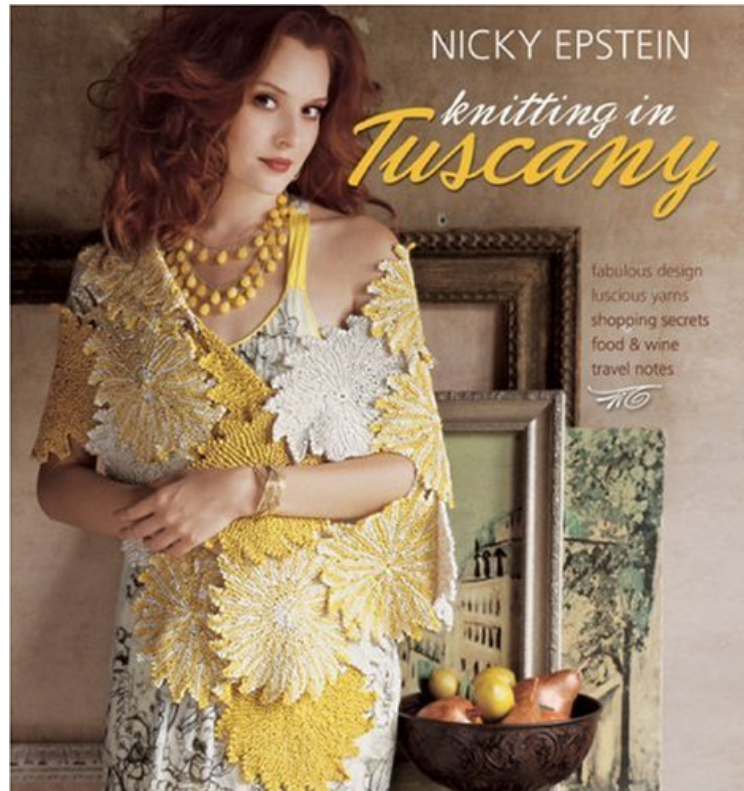

I had never heard of Nicky Epstein, and this was the first book of hers I'd ever seen. I've seen other reviewers say there are mistakes in her instructions, and maybe I'm such a newbie I just haven't noticed, but I have two very lovely scarves and a couple of flowers. It was a bit random, yes, and I wasn't expecting a knitting book to be full of recipes and shopping trip ideas! However, I've been to every city and town she names in Tuscany, and her photos and stories made me ache to go back to all of them again. So I loved that side of the book. The description of the book makes you think it offers a lot of shops to visit. Not so! The book is terrible -- not only are the patterns awful (who would wear or use these things?), but the info about yarn shops is virtually non-existent. In one section, she talks about walking through a town and suggests "look for yarn shops along the way." Really? I didn't need to order this book to know that. It normally sells for nearly \$20 everywhere else, and it's so bad it's not even worth the much lower price you get on . Forget this book and do the research on your own; you'll learn more about Tuscan yarn shops just browsing the Internet or ask the locals as you go.
