There are hats, mittens and gloves, socks and leg warmersThe hats are lovely and most appear to me to be in Fair Isle tradition. The mittens and gloves look Scandinavian and Norwegian. The socks and leg warmers are the strongest section of the book with the most patterns.While this is a nice book to augment one's knitting library, I wouldn't say it's an absolute necessity. It has some nice patterns but none struck me like one I absolutely must have. I liked the book and will keep it but I'm not rushing to knit any specific
