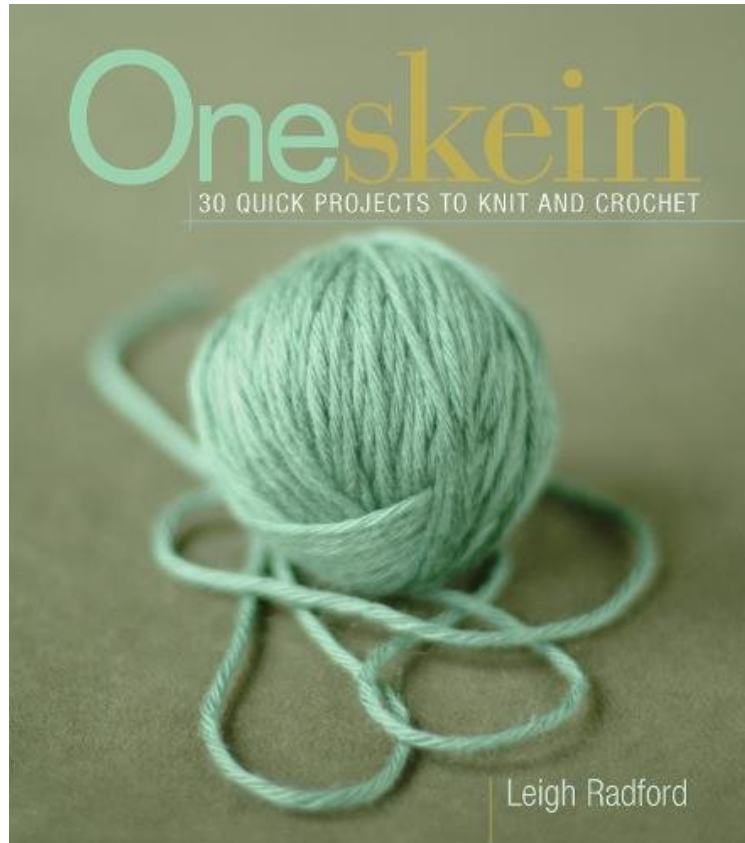

The ones that say that frozen dinner you're looking at has to say "gravy and salisbury steak" instead of the other way around because there's more gravy than salisbury steak. This book practices that law.But it is much better (to me) than a frozen dinner. There are 9 crochet patterns in this book, almost 1/3 of the total patterns and that's very good for this type of book. I personally liked the ruffle scarf the best, but the other patterns seem pretty good. The directions seem to be clear and there is also charts to help you with your crocheting.So why only 4 stars out of 5? Of course, as a crocheter, it would have been great to have more crochet patterns. I know that's selfish, but there you are. The other thing I was disappointed in was the cupcake pattern. It's adorable - but it's knitted. I wish they had printed a crochet version.All in all for a book that includes both patterns, I do think it is worth it for the crochet patterns. I don't usually

say that about the knit/crochet books, but it looks as if somebody took the time to make a good selection of crochet projects. I would advise if you are looking for information on the knitting patterns, check another review. These knitted and crocheted fashion accessories and decorative accents for the home vary in their required levels of skill, but all can be completed quickly and require only one skein of yarn. The stitch patterns and clear instructions make it easy for even procrastinators and the less-than-diligent to create a ruffled cravat, a drawstring bag, a tank top, cozy scarves, arm and leg warmers, lace wristlets, fingerless gloves, a mohair pillow, and even a sweater for a baby. Several projects do not require any new yarn at all instead projects such as the Felted Striped Tote or the Labyrinth Circle Rug are designed using up a skein's worth of leftovers from other projects. A guide to terms and techniques, a resource directory, and a bibliography are also included.
