Ugh...By Who's A Good Kiffum?Not only do some of the figures require scissors to make, but the instructions (and diagrams) are just awful. In most instances, you're required to "Complete Steps" and then "Repeat Steps". Problem is, when you repeat the steps, you must do so without a diagram because the figure looks completely different at that point than it did when you initially completed the steps. The paper is lovely, but the glossy finish is a bit hard to work with, and it doesn't hold up well to creating origami decorations, leaving ugly white creases when the paper is folded multiple times to achieve a certain result. All in all, if I had it to do all over again, I would pass on this kit.

Kit Contains: 1) 80 sheets of origami paper 2) Instruction book 3) One ready-made ornament (pictured on box). For

most of the figures, all you need is a sheet of origami paper and your hands. A few figures call for scissors or a spot of glue in addition to the paper. The patterns on both sides of each sheet of paper have been specially designed to beautify and enhance the figures and help you create your own examples of origami art.
