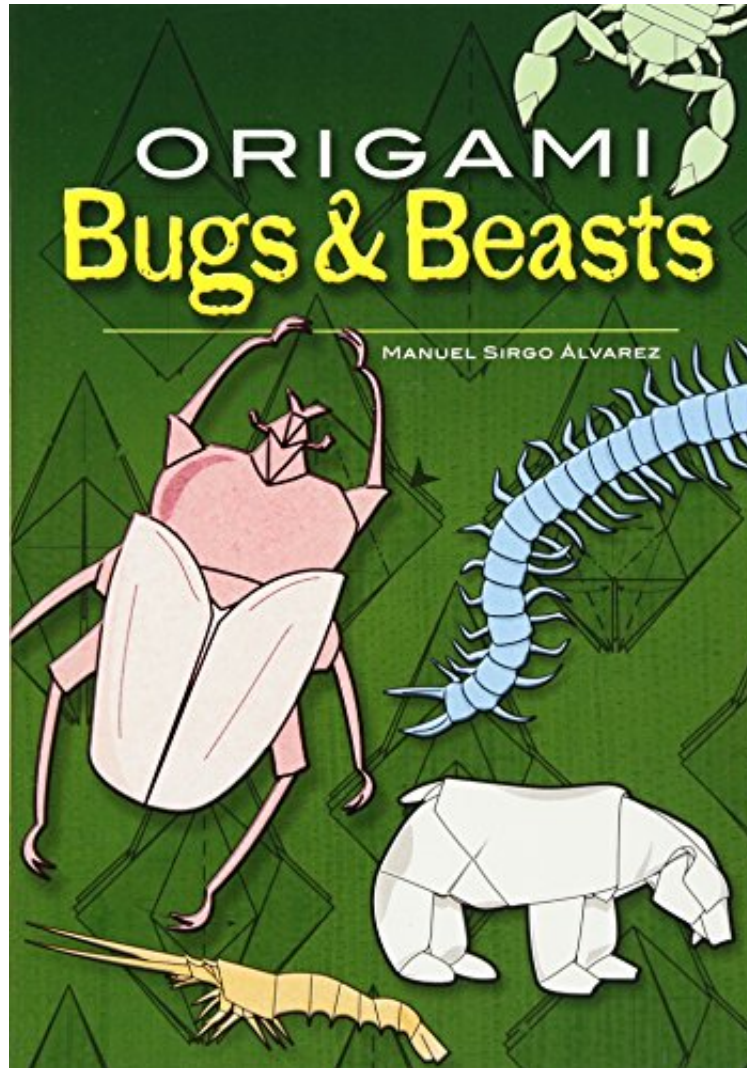

It's just like the cropped the rest out and now I have to strain my eye to see what kind of mystery rabbit fold they did on the smallest of parts.

The patterns are super cool and I do plan on digging into all of them. It's like the instructions were written by a beginner that has never followed instructions. Where you would expect more steps of instructions there is only one. And when there is an obvious succession of folds there's tons of steps. Don't get me started on the subjectivity and vagueness of the written instructions. I've followed instructions in Japanese that were more descriptive (I don't speak or read Japanese).I say get it if you're advanced. Almost all the models are high intermediate to advanced. Plan on spending at least a few hours on each model. Not for beginners at all. The diagrams are sometimes confusing and will require multiple attempts sometimes to understand what is going on. There is very little written out in the steps which could be helpful in making some folds. If you prosper and finish a model you will be overjoyed with the incredible detail in the bugs. Dont use any old piece of paper. Make sure it can withstand the folds and sometimes adding some tape (temporarily) while making a fold so the paper doesnt rip while folding is helpful and after the fold you can remove the tape. One of my favorite origami books defenitly a challenge
