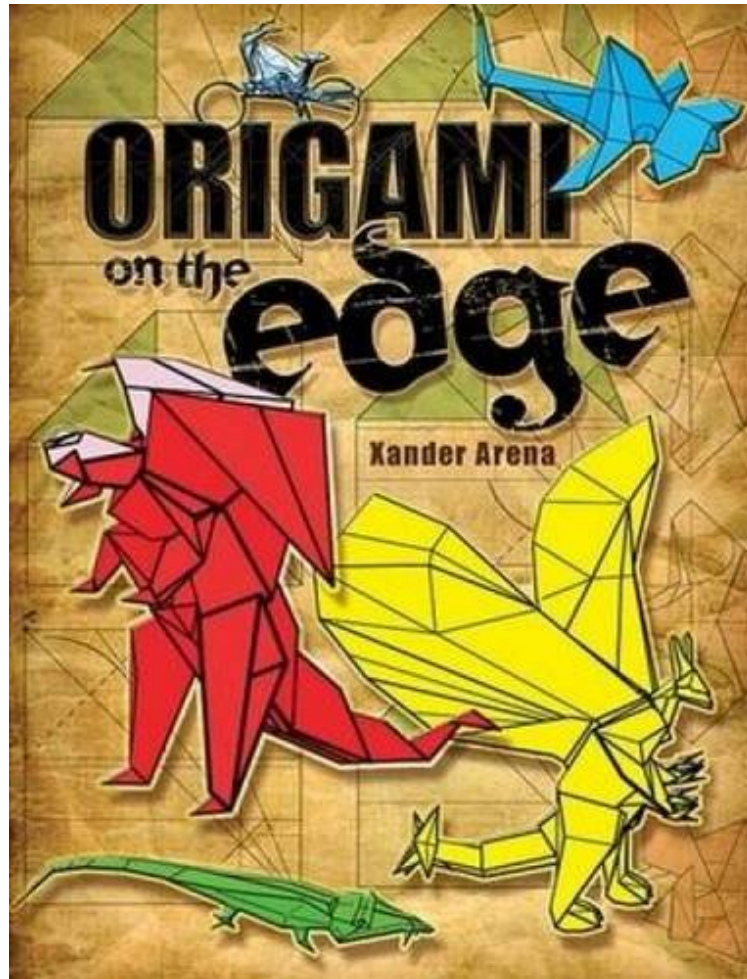

I preordered the book, and sat down to wait for its release. By the time it was released and I got a shipment confirmation, they had changed the cover for the worse, and I hoped the content inside reflected the first cover instead of the second. I was disappointed. The Motorcycle was very good, as was the Komodo Dragon.
