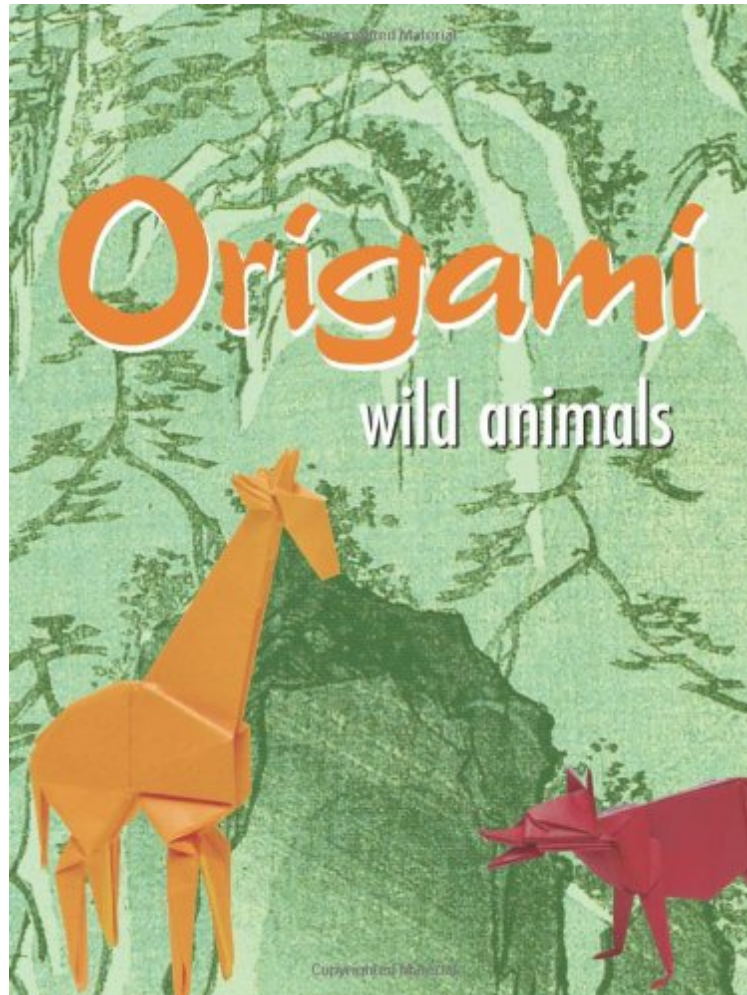

I was expecting something along the lines of Montroll's smaller, staple-bound books (i.e. BIRDS IN ORIGAMI, FAVORITE ANIMALS IN ORIGAMI, or even ORIGAMI AMERICAN STYLE). The models include in this reprint are:Snake (from ANIMAL ORIGAMI FOR THE ENTHUSIAST)Bear (from ANIMAL ORIGAMI FOR THE ENTHUSIAST)Kangaroo (from ANIMAL ORIGAMI FOR THE ENTHUSIAST)Giraffe (from ANIMAL ORIGAMI FOR THE ENTHUSIAST)Fox

They are every bit as creative as his later models but tend to be a little thicker thus requiring thinner paper for good results. Is you have ORIGAMI FOR THE ENTHUSIAST you might want this as there are only two models from it. But if you have ANIMAL ORIGAMI FOR THE ENTHUSIAST then this will be mostly repeats.
