Something is detrimentally wrong with the Instructions here.By Joseph HighbergerWhen I was small, I used to have a wonderful origami book, so when I saw this at our local store I grabbed it. I first began to do the peacock, and then my son wanted the stag, both of which require instructions 1-11 of the owl. Somewhere, there are verbal steps missing, and there is a frequenting of vague wording that leaves you guessing and trying your best to follow the visual directions: "fold the corner this way;" which one, there are many corners - just one example. For both attempts, I was left with only one half of a triangle in the kite figure, when the pictures showed a full one, and no matter how many times I flipped the wings up and down, or back and forth, it did not properly resemble the photo.2 of 2 people found the following review helpful. My daughter wanted to make the owl after opening the gift for Christmas. Although the kit does include some paper, the colored paper shown on the front and back covers of the book for the owl is not included. Not great, but not a show stopper. The first 10 steps were easy enough to follow, but then step 11 says to repeat steps 1 through 6. What? After a few frustrating minutes of fussing around we finally determined that it should have read "Repeat steps 8 through 10".

Don't even get me started on the instructions for folding the wings. I'll give this book another chance, but I'm expecting more errors and frustration. We did eventually end up with a passable origami owl and that is why I'm giving it two stars.
