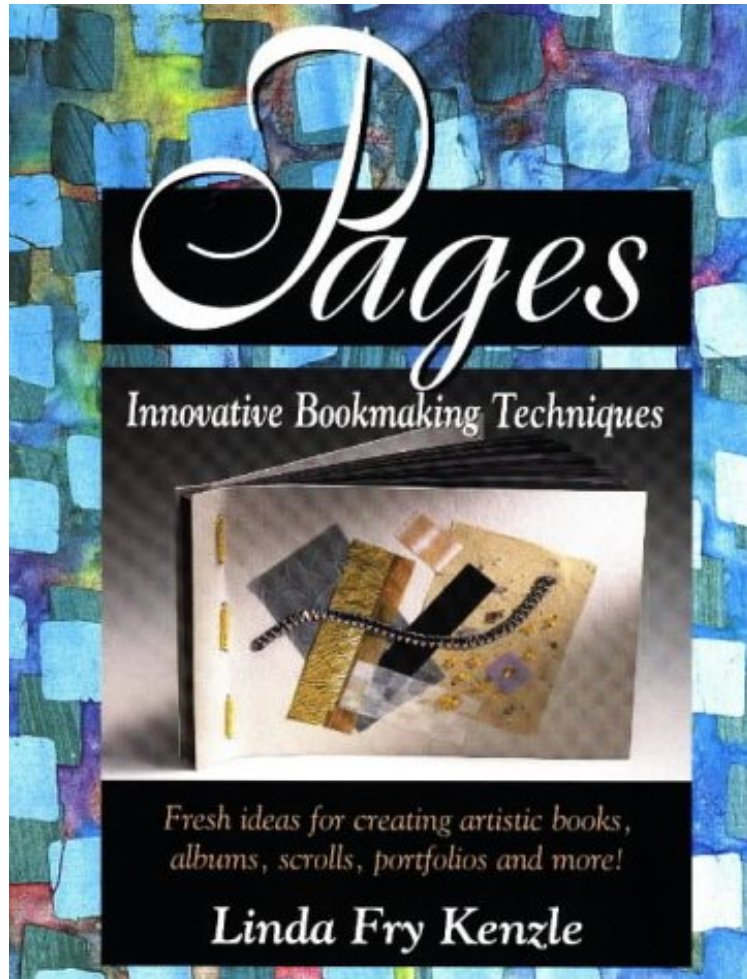

The typographical errors in the book were distracting; the author/artist deserved better. After presenting the how-tos for regular books like folded books, turtle wraps, flutter books, scrolls, and bound books, the author shows you how to make them into pieces of art. Some of the examples are purely sculptural! The author's books and those of many other artists are very inspirational. A real kick in the head! I was so excited by this book I made two books and used the scroll form to make party invitations! Instructions were clear and easy to follow. The map scroll would be perfect for my husband the globe collector. This is a reference book I will refer to often. Besides the instructional section there is an illuminating section on the history of bookmaking and a good explanation of materials. I can't find anything here to quibble about, except perhaps it could have been even longer. Feasting my eyes on the pictures has become a pastime. For me, this is the best book I have found on making handmade books. I have two other titles, but they don't extend my imagination the way this book does. As the author Linda Fry Kenzle says in the Introduction, "Books are powerful." Indeed.
