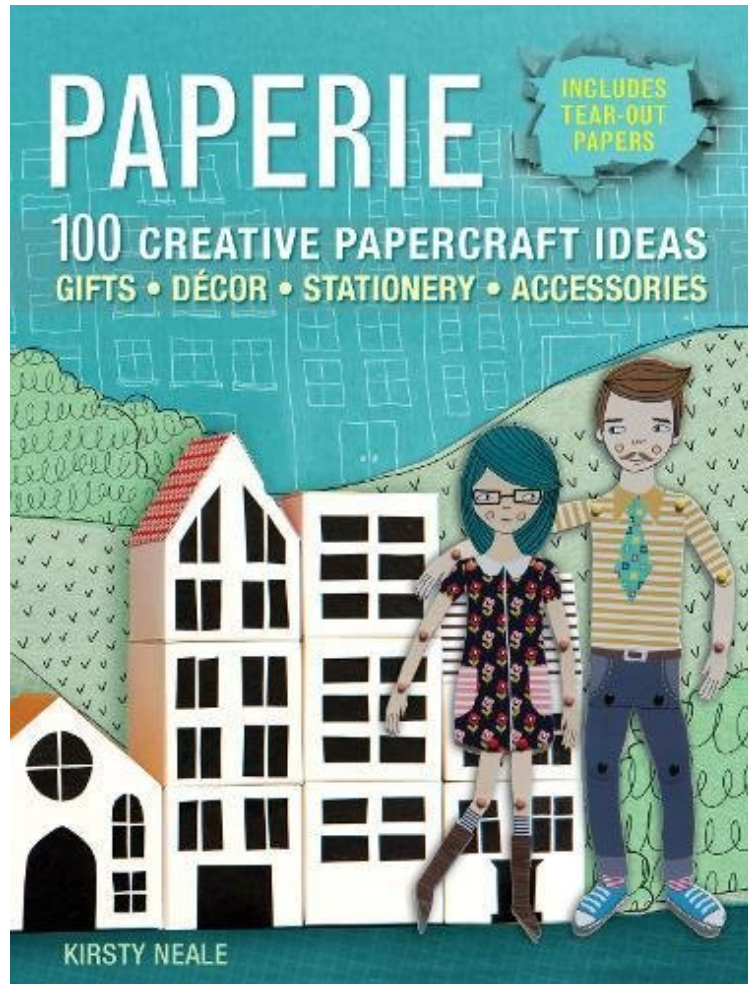

However, there is a lot of overlap -- and pretty much everything can be made and gifted. I was especially delighted

with the book and magazine corner markers, the shaker card, the birdhouse, the folded paper bag, and the blossoms and branch. These are particularly eco and budget friendly.
