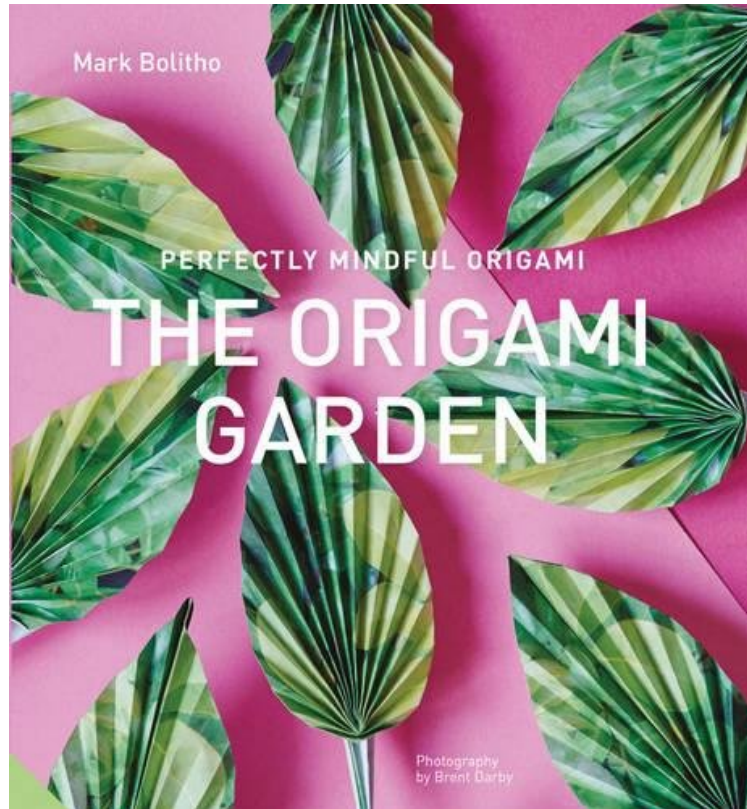

However, there are a few errors in the book that could not be overlooked. ISSUES: If I was a much less experienced folder I don't if I could have even used the book. There are a few places where the diagram refers to an earlier fold and does so incorrectly. I was able to figure out based on the image of where we started what I needed to fold or another model that would get me to the starting point, but these are most certainly errors that should have been caught if test folding had been done on the book prior to publishing. BUY IT ANYWAYS: If you have experience in folding I think you too will be able to work your way through this book. And it is SOOOO worth it. These models are so adorable. The diagrams for the the flower pots alone are worth the cost of the book. FINAL THOUGHTS: If you are an experienced folder and are up for the challenge... BUY IT! LOVELY BOOK BUT NEEDS CORRECTED DIRECTIONS ON PAGE 29....By RicC This is a beautiful origami book. The models are lovely and I looked forward to folding them all. Many of the models are flowers that can be "planted" in a Plant Pot. I had a lot of trouble with the Plants in Pots (Plant Pot) on page 29 because the directions listed ARE NOT CORRECT. There is one glaring error that needs to be noted and it took me awhile to figure it out. It

has to do with the Plants in Pot model on page 29. HERE IS THE CORRECTION....The directions for the Plant Pot begin on page 29. It states "Start with a square...and follow steps 1 to 8 of the Classic Lilly (see pages 64-6). The first 8 steps of the Classic Lilly do not match up with the first step of the Plant Pot. (tried it and there is no way that it works). SO I read a few other models looking for a diagram that matches the first step for the Plant Pot on page 29., What I discovered is that you need to do STEPS ONE to THIRTEEN of the Nuts in a Bowl model and then continue with step 1 of the Plant pot on page 29. The diagram om Step 14 of the Nuts in a Bowl match up with the diagram for step 1 of the Plant Pot on page 29. If you follow what I wrote, you will be able to fold the Plant Pot.Note that the author lists Nuts in Bowl as a ** (Intermediate) model and the Plant Pot as a (*) easy model. I'd list the whole thing as intermediate. It's not that hard to do if you're careful with the sink folds on steps 10 and 11 of the Nuts model.
