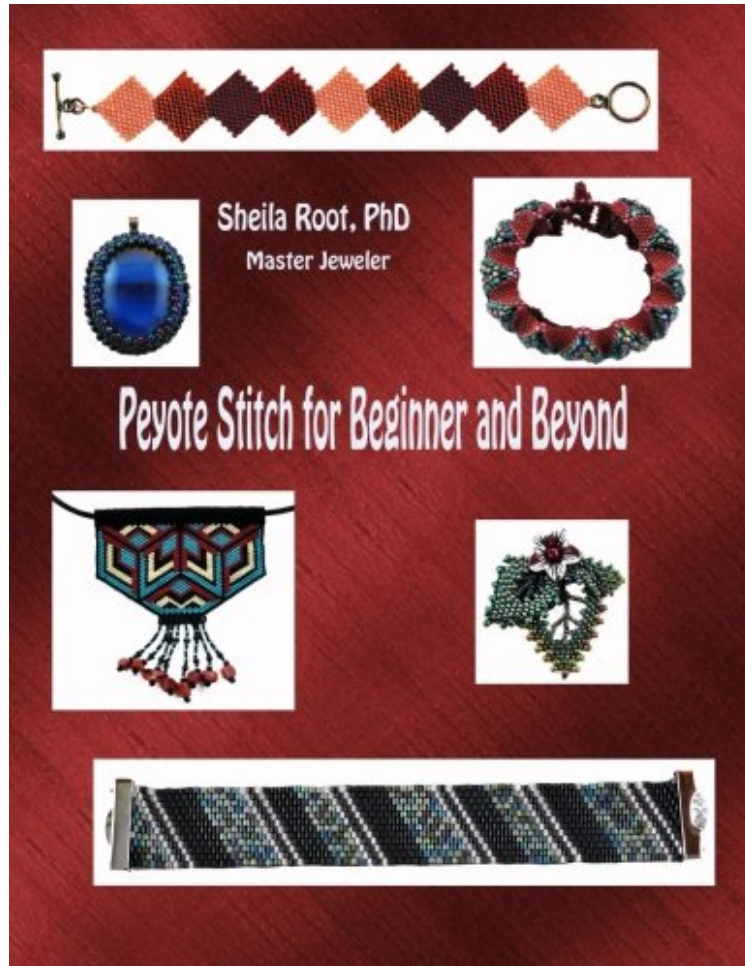

If you are a beginner to traditional Peyote Stitch or know a few basics but want to learn more, this is the book you need. Step by step directions with lots of illustrations are given for flat even count and odd count peyote, two-drop,

and increasing and decreasing as well as basic information on thread, beads, knots, stopper beads, and following patterns. Once you master these basics the book takes you into tubes from flat peyote, spiral tubes, peyote bezels, and shaped dimensional techniques. Ten projects will help you master the techniques, gradually getting more complex as you work through the chapters.

About the Author Sheila Root is a beading artist who has been in the bead business for over twenty years. She has taught hundreds of students in seed bead techniques and basic and advanced stringing techniques as well as wire techniques. A former university professor with degrees in design and a certificate in Master Jewelry, she has been designing and selling "wearable art" for many years.
