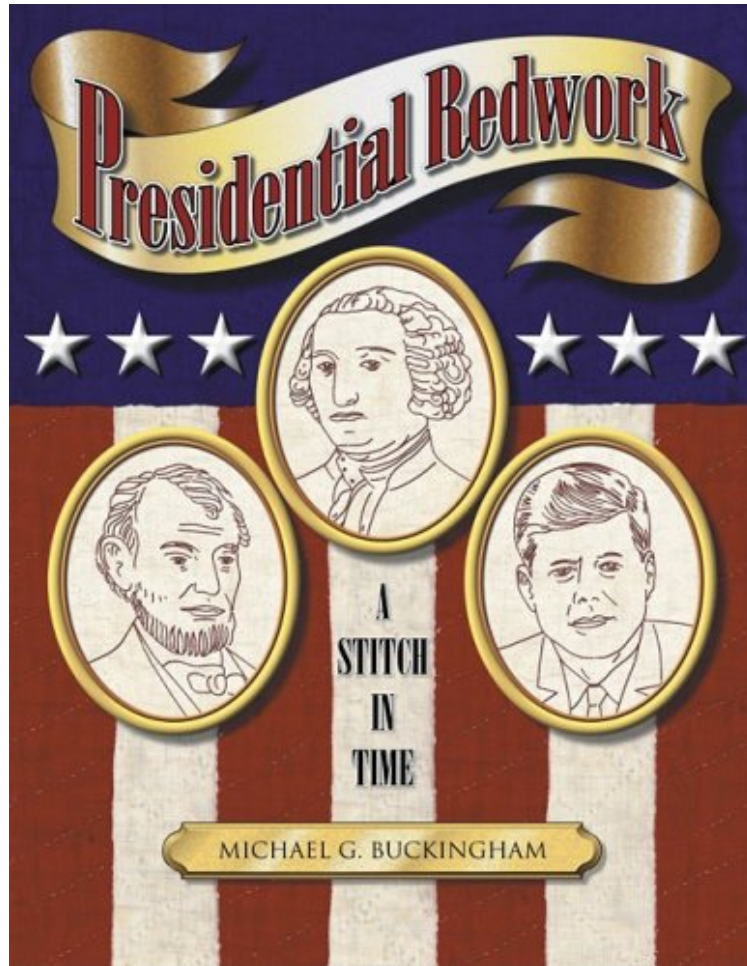

There are several good books available today dealing with redwork embroidery quilting but none quite like "Presidential

Redwork: A Stitch In Time." The author approaches the subject from a new perspective and includes the whole family in the experience. The book features all 42 U.S. presidents in easy to embroider redwork patterns, updating a form of redwork quilting popular at the turn of the century. Also included are bonus patriotic patterns such as various American eagles and U.S. landmarks. While the book isn't being used for quilting, the family can read the interesting biographies on each president, many revealing little known facts about our nation's leaders. Alternatives to embroidery are explored to include children in this fun and historical past-time. Other interesting books on this subject are "Love to Quilt...Penny Squares" and "Favorite Redwork Designs", both published by the American Quilter's Society.

Designed exclusively for the first presidential election of the new millennium, these redwork patterns of the 42 United States presidents are suitable for drawing, painting, embroidery, and quilting. Inspired by traditional History Quilts from 1910, the portraits have been updated to include presidents from Wilson to Clinton. Trivia buffs will especially enjoy the short biography provided for each president. Look for bonus patterns, such as the Liberty Bell, Capitol Building, a selection of American Eagles, and more. Various quilt settings are offered, along with ideas for using these icons of Americana. Perfect for Block of the Month Redwork Clubs, school projects, and embroidery enthusiasts!
