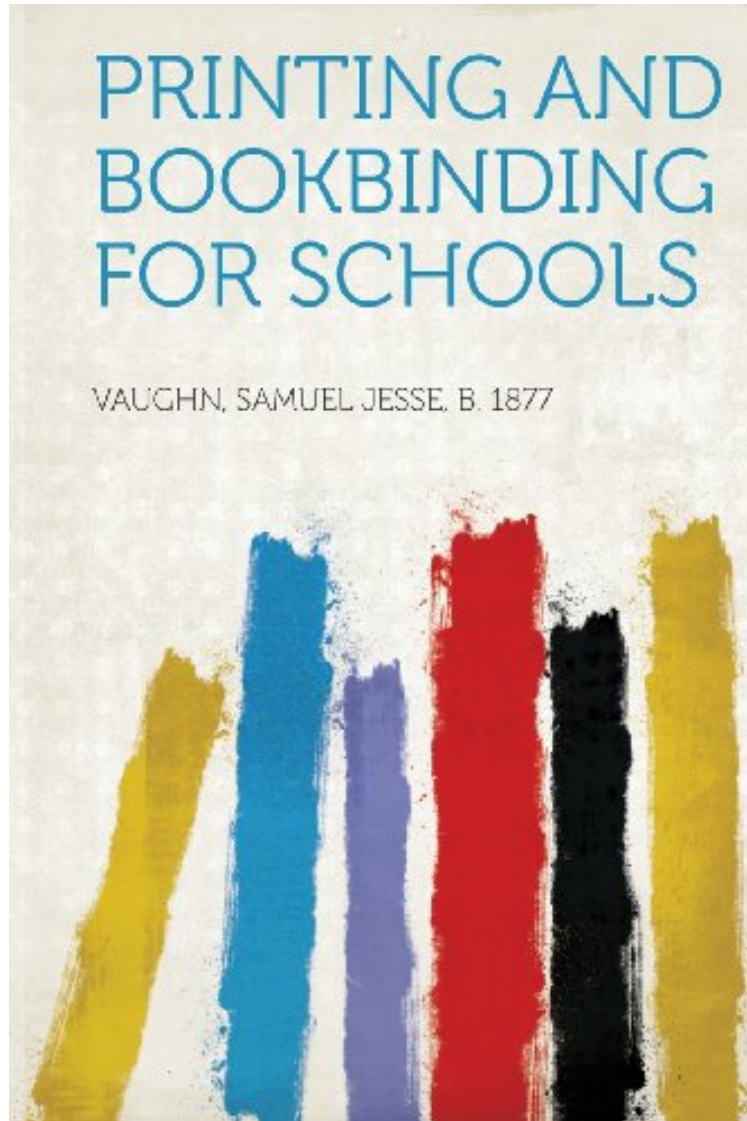

You need to be prepared to translate the poorly OCR's text (such as \Miere for Where, AMien for When, v's for y's, etc). Some parts are unreadable. Page titles frequently appear in the text. It is fairly short, but does introduce you to how the old printing presses were operated. An introduction to the crafts By Rick Cook Written as a textbook for vocational students a century ago, this book does a good job of explaining bookbinding and letterpress printing in a single volume. It assumes a completely equipped print shop, but there's a lot of good how-to information here.

Unlike some other reproductions of classic texts (1) We have not used OCR(Optical Character Recognition), as this leads to bad quality books with introduced typos.
