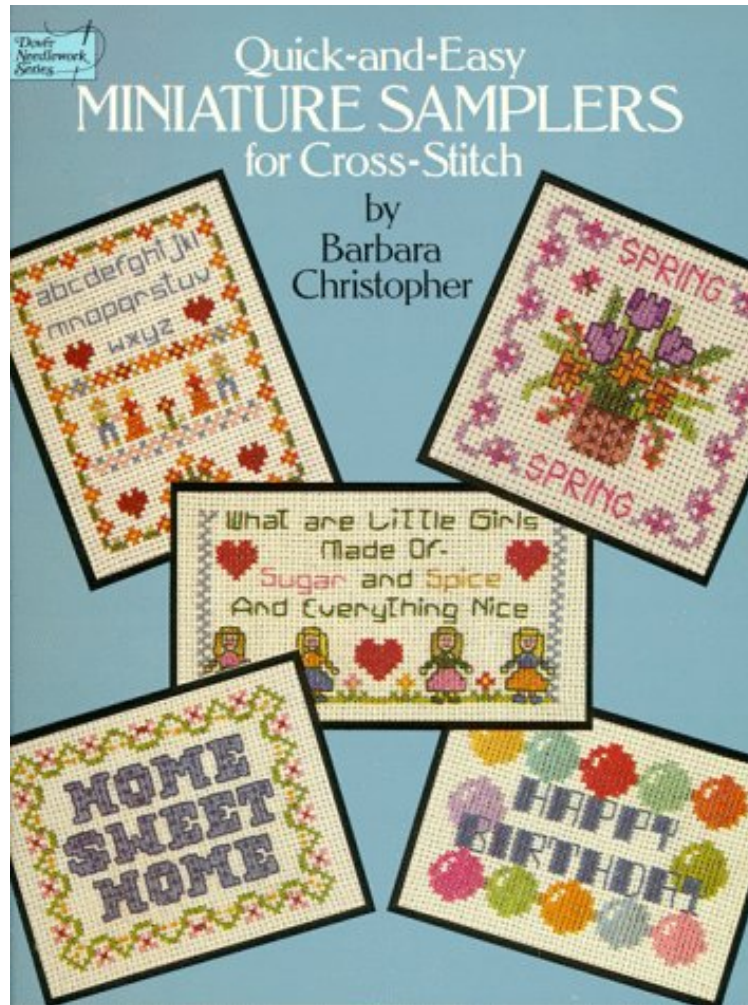

By Jane in Milwaukee I might give this book 3 or even 2 stars because I won't use it. But I'm an advanced stitcher and this is certainly not a bad book to start with. Samplers and girlhood embroideries are all the rage now and if you are new to embroidery or to samplers, start here. Barbara Christopher, Dover's long-standing needlework editor, has done another fine job with cross stitch projects that are clearly graphed. The biggest one has a

stitch count of 40 by 80 but the most common stitch count is about 40 by 40. The number of different colors of flosses used in a given project ranges from 3 to 12. 27 of the itty bitty samplers are shown in color on the inside and outside of the front and back covers but I count 74 different pictures. There are several alphabets included for you to personalize your embroidery. These would make cute projects so go ahead and try your hand. Don't forget to date and sign your work. (Maybe just the year and little initials that you insert somewhere.) These would be perfect to stitch over 1 thread on a high thread count of linen if you wanted to add pizzazz and authenticity to a doll house.
