This book, in the spiral bound Quilt Savvy series, gives clear instructions on how to do thread painting of both small areas on the quilt, and larger ones, based on tulle and added later. There are five exercises/ mini-quilts you can make to practise all of Nancy's suggested techniques. These tell you exactly what areas to do in which colour threads.
